### St. Simon of Cyrene

This Wednesday, December 1st, is the feast of St. Simon of Cyrene. St. Simon is represented in our church in the 5th station of the cross, on the gospel side of the nave. He is the bystander who was forced into helping Jesus carry His cross. He started out objecting to being asked to help but was changed into a believer along the way.

In his time, there were no formal proceedings declaring people saints. However, in the U.S. there is at least one parish named for him. Cyrene is in northern Africa and St. Simon is considered black by some. He was played by Sidney Potier in the 1965 movie "The Greatest Story Ever Told".
