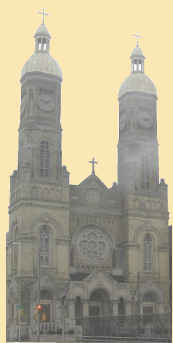
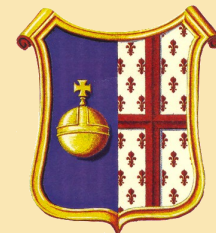

### **Our Lady of Guadalupe**

This Sunday, December 12th, is the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, who is represented in our church in a stained glass window on the Epistle Side, 4th from the front. The Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Juan Diego in 1531. She asked for a church to be built and that he should tell the bishop. On his 3rd attempt, he poured out flowers from his tilma only to find a miraculous image of Our Lady imprinted on it. The church was built, in what is now a suburb of Mexico City. Millions were converted. Millions more still visit the shrine each year.

### **THE "O" ANTIPHONS**

Each day from December 17th through December 23rd has a special antiphon. They are referred to as the Greater Advent Antiphons or the Great "O"s. They can be found in many hand missals under one of those names. They are part of Vespers but would also be good for meditation.

The titles range from O Sapientia to O Rex Gentium in Latin, which is O Wisdom to O King of the Gentiles in English. Some titles are the same in Latin and English such as O Emmanuel. All seven are embodied in the hymn O Come, O Come Emmanuel.

### **Hand Missals For Sale**

If you want a "starter" hand missal, which contains all of the readings for weekday and Sunday Masses, please ask one of the ushers. They have copies of the New Marian Missal for sale at \$20. These missals are provided by the Holy Name Society and usually sell for \$39.95.

You can also get a Roman Catholic Daily Missal from the ushers. This is a \$69.95 missal, available at a \$50 subsidized price.
