FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING - PLENARY INDULGENCE

On this Feast Day the faithful who attend a Mass celebrated in an Apostolate entrusted to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest may gain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions.

Please also know that the Church grants a Plenary Indulgence for the public recitation of the *Act of Reparation of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the Feast of Christ the King*. **ONLY ONE PLENARY INDULGENCE can be gained.**

For a plenary indulgence:

- ◆ You must *accomplish a prescribed work* (while being in the state of grace). For instance, to visit the Blessed Sacrament for at least half an hour or visit the cemetery.
- ◆ *Pray for the intentions* of the Holy Father one Our Father and One Hail Mary.
- ◆ *Go to Confession* within 7 days before or after we have accomplished the prescribed work.
- ◆ Go to communion within 7 days before or after we have accomplished the prescribed work. It is however fitting to go to communion on the same day we accomplish the prescribed work.
- ◆ *Be free from any attachment to sin*, even to venial sin. As this is not so often the case, most plenary indulgences we get, are in fact large partial indulgences.

A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences. Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of a plenary indulgence (each day). We can obtain only one plenary indulgence a day, but in addition to that we may acquire many partial indulgences.

ACT OF REPARATION TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

O, Sweet Jesus, whose overflowing charity for men is requited by so much forgetfulness, negligence, and contempt, behold us prostrate before Thy altar eager to repair by a special act of homage the cruel indifference and injuries to which Thy Loving Heart is everywhere subject. Mindful alas! that we ourselves have had a share in such great indignities, which we deplore from the depths of our hearts, we humbly ask Thy pardon and declare our readiness to atone by voluntary expiation not only for our own personal offenses, but also for the sins of those, who straying far from the path of salvation, refuse in their obstinate infidelity to follow Thee, their Shepherd and Leader, or, renouncing the vows of their baptism, have cast off the sweet yoke of Thy law. We are now resolved to expiate each and every deplorable outrage committed against Thee; we are determined to make amends for the manifold offenses against Christian modesty in unbecoming dress and behavior, for all the foul seductions laid to ensnare the feet of the innocent, for the frequent violations of Sundays and holy days, and the shocking blasphemies uttered against Thee and Thy saints. We wish also to make amends for the insults to which Thy Vicar on earth and Thy priests are subjected, for the profanation, by conscious neglect or terrible acts of sacrilege, of the very Sacrament of Thy Divine Love; and lastly for the public crimes of nations who resist the rights and teaching authority of the Church which thou hast founded. Would, O divine Jesus, that we were able to wash away such abominations with our blood. We now offer, in reparation for these violations of Thy Divine Honor, the satisfaction Thou didst once make to Thy Eternal Father on the cross and which Thou dost continue to renew daily on our altars; we offer it in union with the acts of atonement of Thy Virgin Mother and all the saints and of the pious faithful on earth; and we sincerely promise to make recompense as far as we can with the help of Thy grace, for all neglect of Thy great love and for the sins we and others have committed in the past. Henceforth, we will live a life of unwavering faith, of purity of conduct, of perfect observance of the precepts of the Gospel and especially that of charity. We promise to the best of our power to prevent others from offending Thee and to bring as many as possible to follow Thee. O loving Jesus, through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our model in reparation, deign to receive the voluntary offering we make of this act of expiation; and by the crowning gift of perseverance keep us faithful unto death in our duty and allegiance we owe to Thee so that we may all one day come to that happy home, where Thou, with the Father and the Holy Ghost, livest and reignest God, world without end. Amen.

PRAYER TO CHRIST THE KING

O Lord Jesus Christ, I acknowledge Thee King of the Universe. All that has been created has been made for Thee. Exercise upon me all Thy rights. I renew my baptismal promises, renouncing Satan and all his works and pomps. I promise to live a good Christian life and to do all in my power to procure the triumph of the rights of God and Thy Church. Divine Heart of Jesus, I offer Thee my poor actions in order to obtain that all hearts may acknowledge Thy sacred Royalty, and that thus the reign of Thy peace may be established throughout the universe. Amen.
