THE SEVEN LAST WORDS OF CHRIST ON THE CROSS

In preparation for Easter, we will meditate each week on one of the seven statements that Jesus Christ pronounced on the Cross linking the Gospel of the day. The pictures are from the Cross that has been purchased for our Apostolates for the Veneration of the Cross on Good Friday. It is a wood carved cross, circa 1890, French, 45" tall. Consider making a donation to cover the cost in memory of a beloved one and as your Lenten offering.

AND JESUS SAID: (Luke 23/34)

“FATHER, FORGIVE THEM, FOR THEY KNOW NOT WHAT THEY DO. BUT THEY, DIVIDING HIS GARMENTS, CAST LOTS.”

Today's Gospel features this man who cries out a “O my Lord may I see”, that echoes the word pronounced by Our Lord on the Cross.

It is indeed a great grace that we need to ask for: the grace of self knowledge. We are often blind and unable to see how our actions have incredible consequences, not only down here, but even more in the world to come. If through our good actions we are able to build up a treasure in heaven, it is likely the same but in reverse with our bad actions.

Know yourself. If only God would only reveal a part of the state of our souls, how many times and how gravely we have offended Him and His Father, we would probably die of shame and fall into desperation (Cure of Ars.)

On the contrary, right at the moment of His Crucifixion, as the soldiers mocked Him and gambled His last belonging on earth, as His accusers enjoyed the sight of His death and still challenged His divinity, as only few were standing on His side at the foot of the Tree of our salvation... He forgave them... on account of their ignorance!

From the top of the Cross, on account of my weakness and frailty, He is forgiving me every time I am going with a contrite heart to Confession.

Look at Him: He looks at you and invites you to conversion.
