We will not be accepting any Mass Intentions for 2021 until the end of the year. You will be notified at the end of December when we will be accepting intentions for the first 6 months of 2021. 
Last Friday President Trump told reporters gathered in the White House press briefing room, “Today I’m identifying houses of worship as essential places that provide essential services.” He continued, “Some governors have deemed liquor stores and abortion clinics as essential but have left out churches and other houses of worship. That’s not right.” We should be very grateful for the leadership of President Trump for emphasizing our right to the free exercise of religion and worship.

We have not been at public Mass for more than two months now, and this unprecedented crisis has reminded us that the public Mass is above all the prayer of the Church. In liturgical and public prayer in the Church, it is not primarily the priest who is praying, but, rather, it is the whole Church, the Bride of Christ, who is offering prayer to God, prayer the scope of which is broader than any that could be offered by a priest alone. Liturgical prayer joins that of the angels in bringing before God the glorifi-

cation of the Most Holy Trinity, along with all the needs of God’s kingdom here on earth and also supplication to relieve the sufferings of the Holy Souls in Purgatory. In public prayer, we are like a leaves on the great living tree of the Catholic Church, sharing in her life and in her problems. Likewise, the Church is praying through our mouths: we offer her our tongues to pray in union with her for the accomplishment of all the great works of the Church, and for God’s honor and glory.

In the course of this pandemic crisis, we have been become increasingly aware of the presence of worldly powers which have been active in trying to silence the people of God and to deprive them of their inalienable right to the free exercise of their religion. May public Mass be restored as soon as possible so that we may continue to receive strength from Our Lord Jesus Christ to resist the power of evil.
