- All attendees will need to maintain social distancing of 6 feet from other families and wear a face mask. Please move the chairs around so that the 6-foot rule is kept.

- Sign-up is no longer required as 60 people can be in attendance at Mass.

Dear Faithful,

This Tuesday I will be fifty-two years old, so I have already spent two years as member of the half-century club. Almost ten days ago, during the preparation for Mass, I hurt my back a little while carrying a heavy tabernacle. It seems that with age comes a longer recovery time, so I want to thank you for your kind understanding and additional help that many of you have given for setting up for Mass and putting everything away afterwards. We are living in a time of individualism, when people are rather indifferent and do not seem to care about others, but it is obvious that this crisis we are going through has been pulling

our community together more and has been giving us more opportunities to help and to know each other. Thus, I might say that hurting my back could be seen as a blessing in disguise! Once again, many thanks!

For the last three months we have been celebrating Mass in the parking lot; I do not know when this situation will end, but there is light in the midst of darkness. In today's Gospel We see Jesus work a miracle in order to console a widowed mother by restoring her dead son to life. This was an expression of His Mercy for us. I pray that God's Mercy continues to turn our current difficult situation into good.

A 40-day campaign of prayer, fasting, and sacrifice according to our state in life will start on September 14, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. Indeed, in times of extraordinary difficulty in our Church and in our world, extraordinary efforts are needed so that Christ may reign and that He may reign especially in

the United States of America in this critical hour of history.

Specifically, we are asking everyone to make a spiritual commitment to do the following 3 things consistently every single day from September 14 through October 25:

- Pray at least 5 decades of the Most Holy Rosary. Imitate at least 1 of the virtues it contains.
- Make a sincere Act of Contrition.
- Pray the St. Michael Prayer.

Our Lady promised that the prayerful recitation of the Holy Rosary would convert sinners because she is the Mother of Mercy and the Hope of Sinners. In this context, let us make regular Confession, daily acts of Contrition, and frequent sacrifices and fasting in satisfaction for sin. Mary may use this example of repentance to touch hearts which have become hardened.

True devotion to Mary and her Rosary includes imitating her virtues. How can we instruct, encourage, and inspire the faithful to the Rosary's recitation but also to its imitation in everyday words and deeds? *Veritatem facientes in caritate* means living the Rosary's lessons and virtues each day so that the Reign of Christ the King can be extended one person at a time everywhere around us.

With humble trust and confidence, let us all commit to making extraordinary efforts from September 14 through October 25 that Christ may reign through Our Lady of the Holy Rosary.
