

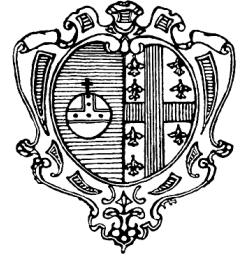

At the end of each year we exchange with each other “our best wishes” for the coming year. And we do well.

One of my spiritual directors asked me once if my wishes were like assorted chocolates in a box. There are many from which to choose and as you offer them to your friends it is always the best that go first... the ultimate chocolate in the box has, by the time you have passed them around, become the best of them all since it is the last... while at the beginning it was considered to be the worst of the box...

So he wondered how many best wishes I had already given before passing mine to him...

But our wishes are not like chocolates in a box. They are more likely like the flame of a candle. You can pass them to many; the flame never fades. It burns, warms and gives light as well to all of your friends.

As we start the new year we want to look back at our past year... In January 2013, we were already exchanging these flames and it is time to wonder what happened to our dreams and desires. Did they come true? What did we do to make them become reality? How grateful are we for their fulfillment? Why did they fail? Were we too optimistic in our goals or too greedy?

With my blessing and gratitude for this first year passed at your side.

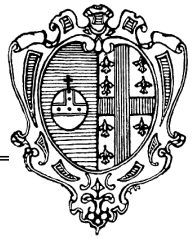
May the Blessed Virgin Mary guide and protect you throughout this New Year of Grace.
