### HOW MANY TIMES DOES THE PRIEST TURN AROUND AND WHY ?

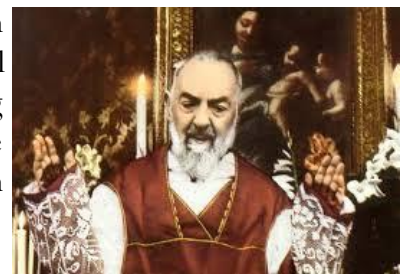
In the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, it seems that the Priest 'turns his back' from the faithful. In reality he turns in the same direction than every one: toward the East. The reason for this is the promise made by the prophets referring to the Messiah as to 'the rising sun', or the 'dayspring'. Indeed the Messiah is to come through the Golden Gate of Jerusalem, that is the East gate of the City. In the books of Malachi and of Job, the Messiah is compared to the fire of the coming Sun that will burn and purify, and then reveal the good. In St. Matthew Our Lord Jesus Christ Himself announces His second coming that will be clearly seen. "Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ (Messiah), or there; believe it not. For there shall be false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Behold, I have told you before. Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not. For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall the coming of the Son of man be. (Matthew 24-23)

The whole community is then physically turned in this direction in a sign of hope (In certain medieval churches an open window behind the altar let people see the sky)

Five times, the priest turns around to greet those assisting at Mass, inviting the full communion of the Saints to join him (The priest turns around even when he celebrates the Mass alone, in private.)

He turns before the three prayers that are the opening Collect just before the readings of the Epistle, before the Prayer of Offertory, before the Orate Fratres and before the Post Communion.

For the three prayers he adds the greeting 'Dominus Vobiscum' which is an ancient formula inviting all to be united in God. The priest kisses the altar - all blessing and peace come from Christ - and turns on his right. After saying 'Dominus Vobiscum', he turns back on his left. For the Orate Fratres and the Final blessing, the Priest on the contrary completes his rotation, taking with him all the prayers and intentions of the faithful.
