THE SEVEN SAYING OF CHRIST ON THE CROSS

In preparation for Easter, we will meditate each week on one of the seven statements that Jesus Christ pronounced on the Cross linking the Gospel of the day. The pictures are from the Cross that has been purchased for our Apostolates for the Veneration of the Cross on Good Friday. It is a wood carved cross, circa 1890, French, 45" tall. Consider making a donation to cover the cost in memory of a beloved one and as your Lenten offering.

When Jesus therefore had seen His Mother and the disciple whom He loved standing, He said to His Mother, "WOMAN BEHOLD THY SON." After that He said to the disciple, "BEHOLD THY MOTHER." (John 19.26)

The commentators see here the foundation, the Institution, of the Church.

Previously Our Lord Jesus Christ promised His disciples that He ~~will~~ would not leave them alone. Besides the fact that He is sending the Holy Ghost to teach them, to explain all that they were told, he entrusted them to His Own Mother.

We might be surprised that Jesus uses the word "woman" to address His Mother at this last moment. We could have expected a more tender and childlike word like "mom" or at least "mother." He did say "Woman."

Indeed, at that moment He reveals to the world that the Blessed Virgin is The Woman announced by Genesis 3-15 quoted last week. She is the Woman that will crush the head of the devil. She is the New Eve. She is the Mother of God. She is the Mother of the Church, the Universal Model of all women, virgins and mothers.

More than that, She is given to us - represented by St. John - as our own Mother.

If we do not want the Word of God falling onto infertile ground, let us make sure that we take this Mother into the homes of our souls first, but more than that into the hearts of our houses. St. John indeed took Her home. Let us do the same and make sure that in a sound and visible place, we keep an image, a picture or a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

It will be **the** source of many blessings for our households.
