

Consecration to Mary of the Institute Apostolate in the Bay Area

Total Consecration to Mary according to St. Louis de Montfort's True Devotion

"One day, through the Rosary and the Scapular I will save the world" Our Lady to St. Dominic

St. Louis de Montfort recommended a 33 day preparation for the consecration to Mary (adding, however, that this was being lengthened or shortened at will) by the means of meditation and spiritual reading.

The first week is spent recognizing and rejecting the **Spirit of the World**, the second week in **Knowing oneself**, the third **Knowing Mary**, the fourth week in **Knowing Jesus**. The fifth and final week is devoted to **Final Preparations for the Consecration**.

The Consecration will take place at St. Margaret Mary on December 8th, the feast of the Immaculate Conception, and at Our Mother of Perpetual Help Chapel in Santa Clara on the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patron of the Americas, on December 12th.
