

SUMMER CHANT CLASS LECTURE: CHANT AND POLYPHONY

At the end of July, the weekly Chant Class will feature a two-part conference on sacred music open to the general public. Enrollment in the chant class is not required to attend. The subject of these conferences will be the theological and anthropological origins of polyphony, a musical texture which has been called by Pius X the only form of music to have "earned a place side by side with Gregorian Chant". This topic will be illumined through the prism of Italian musicologist Francesco Ciabattoni, who shows how medieval poet Dante Alighieri allocates the three musical textures of cacophony, monophony, and polyphony respectively to the three parts of his masterwork, The Divine Comedy. **The dates are Tuesday, July 20th and Tuesday, July 27th at 7:45pm in the church hall.**

HOLY MATRIMONY:


Couples planning to marry at the Oratory must call the rectory for the proper instructions.
