

This arrangement will benefit the Oratory's operations and breathe life back into the building vacated by KIPP Schools one year ago.

Join us for a 4-day Choir Festival with Eucharistic Adoration, a grand dinner, brunch, & Solemn High Mass in honor of Christ the King.





### HOLY MATRIMONY:


Couples planning to marry at the Oratory must call the rectory for the proper instructions.
