



ORATORY CLEANING



ORATORY CAMPUS IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements to the St. Francis de Sales Oratory campus continue to take place. Our next major investment concerns the flooring in the church basement. Many of you have already remarked that renovations to the large room under the south transept were being effectuated over the summer. Thanks to volunteers and several contractors, the walls were patched, painted and stenciled and new lights installed. We are now ready to install an LVT floor in order to finish out the room intended for use by the oratory choir. At the same time, the same flooring will be installed in the main room of the church basement and associated vestibules. Funding for this project will come from a mixture of economies made in the current fiscal year budget for the Oratory, though any assistance by interested parties would be greatly appreciated. The entire project will cost around \$52,000.00. Please contact the Oratory office if you have any questions. The rector's intention is to brighten up a space so often frequented by Oratory Members and to render it more agreeable and desirable to use.
