## From the Rectors Desk...

Dear Faithful and Friends of St. Francis de Sales Oratory,

My superiors have informed me that I will be given a new assignment after the General Chapter at the end of August. Also, our dear Father Avis will be transferred to another assignment. More details will be published on August 3<sup>rd</sup> in a letter of the Vicar General and Provincial Superior for the US, the Very Rev. Msgr. R. Michael Schmitz.

These changes were decided well before the recent appointment of His Grace, the Most Reverend Raymond L. Burke, who had already agreed to them while still Archbishop of St. Louis. Two of our confreres will succeed us, and the life at the Oratory and the presence of the Institute will remain unchanged.

I will leave the United States to preach a retreat for the Society of the Sacred Heart in Germany; then I will make my own retreat, have some days of vacation and finally, participate in our General Chapter in Gricigliano, Italy. I will return to St. Louis on August 30<sup>th</sup>. Father Avis will remain at the Oratory during this time. Fr. Avis and I are deeply grateful for our time at the Oratory, and we will continue to pray for all of you in the future.
