Gospel: Matt. 28, 18-20. At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: “All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you all days, even unto the consummation of the world.”

Secret: Sanctify the victim of this offering, we beseech You, O Lord, our God, by the invocation of Your holy name; and through the same render us an everlasting offering to You.

Postcommunion: May the reception of this sacrament, O Lord, our God, as also the confession of our faith in the holy and everlasting Trinity, and of its undivided Unity, profit us for the health of body and soul.
