### THIRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

**Introit: Ps. 24, 16. 18.** Look toward me, and have pity on me, O Lord, for I am alone and afflicted. Put an end to my affliction and my suffering, and take away all my sins, O my God. **Ps. 24, 1.2.** To You, I lift up my soul, O Lord. In You, O my God, I trust; let me not be put to shame.

**Prayer:** O God, the Protector of those who hope in You, without Whom nothing is strong, nothing holy: multiply upon us Your mercy, that with You as our ruler and guide, we may so pass through temporal things, as not to lose those which are eternal.

**Epistle: 1 Pt. 5, 6-11.** Beloved: Humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in the time of visitation; cast all your anxiety upon Him, because He cares for you. Be sober, be watchful! For your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, goes about seeking someone to devour. Resist him, steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same suffering befalls your brethren all over the world. But the God of all grace, Who has called us unto His eternal glory in Christ Jesus, will Himself, after we have suffered a little while, perfect, strengthen and establish us. To Him is the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

**Gradual: Ps. 54, 23. 17.19.** Cast your care upon the Lord, and He will support you. *V.* When I called upon the Lord, He heard my voice from those who war against me. Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* Ps. 7, 12. A just judge is God, strong and patient; is He angry every day? Alleluia.

**Gospel: Luke 15, 1-10.** At that time, the publicans and sinners were drawing near to Jesus to listen to Him. And the Pharisees and the Scribes murmured, saying, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." But He spoke to them this parable, saying, "What man of you having a hundred sheep, and losing one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the desert, and go after that which is lost, until he finds it? And when he has found it, he lays it upon his shoulders rejoicing. And on coming home he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, because I have found my sheep that was lost.' I say to you that, even so, there will be joy in heaven over one sinner who repents, more than over ninety-nine just who have no need of repentance. Or what woman, having ten drachmas, if she loses one
