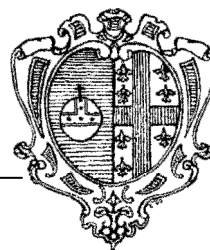

**SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST**

**Introit: Ps. 118, 137. 124.** You are just, O Lord, and Your ordinance is right. Deal with Your servant according to Your kindness. **Ps. 118, 1.** Happy are they whose way is blameless, who walk in the law of the Lord.

**Prayer:** Grant to Your people, we beseech You, O Lord, to avoid every contamination of the devil, and, with pure minds, to follow You, the only God.

**Epistle: Eph. 4, 1-6.** Brethren: I, the prisoner in the Lord, exhort you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all humility and meekness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, careful to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace: one body and one Spirit, even as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one Baptism, one God and Father of all, Who is above all, and throughout all, and in us all, Who is blessed forever and ever. Amen.

**Gradual: Ps. 32, 12. 6.** Happy the nation whose God is the Lord, the people the Lord has chosen for His own inheritance. √. By the word of the Lord the heavens were made; by the breath of His mouth all their host.

Alleluia, alleluia. √. **Ps. 101, 2.** O Lord, hear my prayer, and let my cry come to You. Alleluia.

**Gospel: Matt. 22, 34-46.** At that time, the Pharisees came to Jesus and one of them, a doctor of the Law, putting Him to the test, asked Him, “Master, which is the great commandment in the Law?” Jesus said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with your whole heart, and with your whole soul, and with your whole mind.’ This is the greatest and first commandment. And the second is like it, ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets.” Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus questioned them, saying, “What do you think of the Christ? Mass Intention Policy

- a) Each family will be allowed 5 Masses per year. 4 weekday Masses and 1 Sunday Mass. b) Masses can not be scheduled for more than a year in advance. (Canon Law # 953) c) All Mass requests must be personally arranged with our Parish Secretary, Terry. d) Requests for specific dates may be honored. Nonetheless, they may be changed according to need. e) Urgent requests will be considered.
