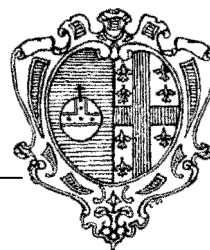

NINETEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Introit: "I am the salvation of the people," says the Lord; "in whatever tribulation they shall cry to Me, I will hear them; and I will be their Lord forever." **Ps. 77, 1.** Hearken, My people, to My teaching; incline your ears to the words of My mouth.

Prayer: Almighty and merciful God, in Your bounty, graciously defend us from all that is hurtful; that, free in mind and body, we may with ready minds carry out the things that are Yours.

Epistle: Eph. 4, 23-28. Brethren: Be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and put on the new man, which has been created according to God in justice and holiness of truth. Wherefore, put away lying and speak truth each one with his neighbor, because we are members of one another. "Be angry and do not sin"; do not let the sun go down upon your anger; do not give place to the devil. He who was wont to steal, let him steal no longer; but rather let him labor, working with his hands at what is good, that he may have something to share with him who suffers need.

Gradual: Ps. 140, 2. Let my prayer come like incense before You, O Lord. *V.* The lifting up of my hands, like the evening sacrifice.

Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* **Ps. 104, 1.** Give thanks to the Lord, invoke His name; make known among the nations His deeds. Alleluia.

Gospel: Matt. 22, 1-14. At that time, Jesus spoke to the chief priests and the Pharisees in parables, saying, "The kingdom of heaven is like a king who made a marriage feast for his son. And he sent his servants to call in those invited to the marriage feast, but they would not come. Again he sent out other servants, saying, 'Tell those who are invited, behold, I have prepared my dinner; my oxen and fatlings are killed, and everything is ready; come to the marriage feast.' But they made light of it, and went off, one to his farm, and another to his business; and the rest laid hold of the servants, treated them shamefully, and killed them. But when the king heard of it, he was angry; and he sent his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burnt their city. Then he

PONTIFICAL RIGHT ANNIVERSARY

On the first anniversary of the Pontifical Decree *Saeculorum Rex*, which bestowed the Pontifical Right on the Institute of Christ the King, the Institute's seminarians and the seminary superiors, along with the Sisters Adorers, attended the Holy Father's general audience on October 7 in Saint Peter's Square in order to greet and to thank Pope Benedict XVI in person for this document.
