FEAST OF THE HOLY NAME OF JESUS

Introit: Phil. 2, 10-11. At the Name of Jesus every knee should bend of those in heaven, on earth, and under the earth, and every tongue should confess that the Lord Jesus Christ is in the glory of God the Father. **Ps. 8, 2.** O Lord, our Lord, how glorious is Your Name over all the earth!

Prayer: O God, You have established Your Only-begotten Son as the Savior of mankind, and commanded that He should be called Jesus; mercifully grant that we who venerate His holy Name on earth, may also be filled with the enjoyment of the vision of Him in heaven.

Epistle: Acts 4, 8-12. In those days, Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said, "Rulers of the people and elders, if we are on trial today about a good work done to a cripple, as to how this man has been cured, be it known to all of you and to all the people of Israel that in the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Whom you crucified, Whom God has raised from the dead, even in this Name does he stand here before you, sound. This is 'The stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone.' Neither is there salvation in any other. For there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."

Gradual: Ps. 105, 47. Save us, O Lord, our God, and gather us from among the nations, that we may give thanks to Your holy Name and glory in praising You. *V.* **Isa. 63, 16.** You, O Lord, are our Father and our Redeemer, from everlasting is Your Name.

Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* **Ps. 144, 21.** May my mouth speak the praise of the Lord, and may all flesh bless His holy Name. *Alleluia.*

Gospel: Luke 2, 21. At that time, when eight days were fulfilled for the circumcision of the Child, His Name was called Jesus, the Name given Him by the angel before He was conceived in the womb.

Offertory: Ps. 85, 12. 5. I will give thanks to You, O Lord my God, with all my heart, and I will glorify Your Name forever. For You, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in kindness to all who call upon You. *Alleluia.*

Secret: May Your blessing, most merciful God, by which every creature lives, sanctify, we beseech You, this our sacrifice, which we offer to You, to the glory of the Name of Your Son our Lord Jesus Christ, that it may please Your Majesty as an act of praise, and profit us to salvation.

Communion: Ps. 85, 9-10. All the nations You have made shall come and worship You, O Lord, and glorify Your Name. For You are great, and do wondrous deeds; You alone are God. *Alleluia.*

Postcommunion: O almighty and eternal God, You have created and redeemed us; graciously regard our prayers, and vouchsafe to accept with a benign and favorable countenance the sacrifice of the Saving Victim which we have offered to Your Majesty, in honor of the Name of Your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ: that, through the infusion of Your grace into us, we may rejoice over our names having been written under the glorious Name of Jesus, as a pledge of eternal predestination.
