### EASTER SUNDAY

**Introit: Ps. 138, 18, 5, 6.** I arose, and am still with You, alleluia; You rest Your hand upon Me, alleluia; Your knowledge is too wonderful, alleluia, alleluia. Ps. 138, 1.2. O Lord, You have probed Me and You know Me; You know when I sit and when I stand. *V.* Glory.

**Prayer:** O God, Who on this day, through Your Only-begotten Son, overcame death, and opened to us the gate of everlasting life: as, by Your anticipating grace, You breathe good desires into our hearts, so also, by Your gracious help, bring them to good effect.

**Epistle: 1 Cor. 5, 7-8.** Brethren: Purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new dough, as you really are without leaven. For Christ, our Passover, has been sacrificed. Therefore let us keep festival, not with the old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

**Gradual: Ps. 117, 24. 1.** This is the day the Lord has made; let us be glad and rejoice in it. *V.* Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, for His mercy endures forever. Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* **1 Cor. 5, 7.** Christ, our Passover, has been sacrificed.

### Sequence:

O Christians, to the Paschal Victim bring:  
Of praise the sacrificial Offering.  
For the sheep the Lamb His Blood did shed:  
The sinless Christ in the sinners' stead:  
With God the guilty reconciling.  
The Life with Death did fiercely strive:  
Through dying the Leader now reigns alive.

O Mary, what did your wond'ring eyes adore?  
"I saw the tomb of One Who dies no more!  
The glorious risen Lord was shown to me:  
The napkin, linen cloths there lying:  
I heard the angels testifying.  
Yes, Christ is ris'n and you shall see  
Your Hope and mine in Galilee!"

We know that Christ rose from the grave:  
O conqu'ring King, us sinners save.  
Amen. Alleluia.

**Gospel: Mark 16, 1-7.** At that time, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome, bought spices, that they might go and anoint Jesus. And very early on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb, when the sun had just risen. And they were saying to one another, "Who will roll the stone back from the entrance of the tomb for us?" And looking up they saw that the stone had been rolled back, for it was very large. But on entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting at the right side, clothed in a white robe, and they were amazed. He said to them, "Do not be terrified. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, Who was crucified. He has risen, He is not here. Behold the place where they laid Him. But go, tell His disciples and Peter that He goes before you into Galilee; there you shall see Him, as He told you."

**Offertory: Ps. 75, 9. 10.** The earth feared and was silent when God arose for judgment. Alleluia.

**Secret:** Accept, we beseech You, O Lord, the prayers of Your people together with the sacrifice they offer, that what has been begun by these Easter mysteries, may by Your working profit us to everlasting salvation.

**Communion: 1 Cor. 5, 7. 8.** Christ, our Passover, has been sacrificed, alleluia: therefore let us keep festival with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

**Postcommunion:** Pour forth upon us, O Lord, the Spirit of Your love, that those whom You have filled with the Easter sacraments may, by Your goodness, be of one mind.
