Sunday after Ascension

Introit: Ps. 26, 7, 8, 9. Hear, O Lord, the sound of my call, alleluia; to You my heart speaks; Your glance I seek; Your presence, O Lord, I seek. Hide not Your face from me, alleluia, alleluia. Ps. 26, 1. The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom should I fear?

Prayer: Almighty and everlasting God, grant us both ever to have a will devoted to You, and to serve Your Majesty with a sincere heart.

Epistle: 1 Pet. 4, 7-11. Beloved: Be prudent and watchful in prayers. But above all things have a constant mutual charity among yourselves; for charity covers a multitude of sins. Be hospitable to one another without murmuring. According to the gift that each has received, administer it to one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If anyone speaks, let it be as with words of God. If anyone ministers, let it be as from the strength that God furnishes; that in all things God may be honored through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Alleluia, alleluia. *V. Ps. 46, 9.* The Lord reigns over all the nations, God sits upon His holy throne. *Alleluia. V. John 14, 18.* I will not leave you orphans; I go away and I come to you, and your heart shall rejoice. Alleluia.

Gospel: John 15, 26, 27; 16, 1-4. At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: "When the Advocate has come, Whom I will send you from the Father, the Spirit of truth Who proceeds from the Father, He will bear witness concerning Me. And you also bear witness, because from the beginning you are with Me. These things I have spoken to you that you may not be scandalized. They will expel you from the synagogues. Yes, the hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think he is offering worship to God. And these things they will do because they have not known the Father nor Me. But these things I have spoken to you, that when the time for them has come you may remember that I told you."

Offertory: Ps. 46, 6. God mounts His throne amid shouts of joy; the Lord, amid trumpet blasts. Alleluia.

Secret: May this spotless sacrifice purify us, O Lord, and infuse into our minds the vigor of heavenly grace.

Communion: John 17, 12, 13, 15. Father, while I was with them, I kept them whom You have given Me, alleluia; but now I am coming to You: I do not pray that You take them out of the world, but that You keep them from evil, alleluia, alleluia.

Postcommunion: Being replenished with the sacred gifts, grant us, we beseech You, O Lord, always to continue in thanksgiving.

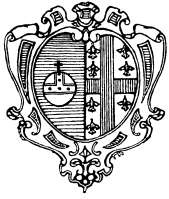

What do we do?*" So, as a filler, allow me to share with you this picture and a couple of comments of my trip to Quito, Ecuador, where I went to spend my "week of rest".

Our Lady of Good Success was my "first" devotion to Our Lady, as my family lived in Quito when I was 7 years old. The majestic miraculous image, the stories of Her apparitions and prophecies, were to cause in me a deep and lasting impression. Never did I ever imagine, then, that 36 years later I would return as a Priest and celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on Her altar. Much, much has changed in Quito... except Her. If I can say without disrespect: it was like meeting with an old and good friend again. It was wonderful! Besides: She is like "alive"! I had tons of things to say and ask Our Blessed Mother. Tons of intentions to place at Her feet, and You, very dear Faithful, were in the heart of it. I took with me a list of ALL your names, and in the long and blessed hours I spent with Her, I remembered each and every one of you before Her. Despite being away from you, it was a marvelous week! Don't worry... you'll be hearing about it for a long time... in catechism, theology class, etc. I brought back, for each one of you, a little remembrance of Our Good Mother. I hope each one of you can be there one day. There is such a presence of Our Lady there! So much peace! It's "the closest to Heaven you'll ever get", if you know what I mean. It was not hard coming back. But sure it was hard leaving Her. Nonetheless: I'm happy to be back. Thank you for your prayers.
