Fourth Sunday after Easter

Introit: Ps. 97, 1. 2. Sing to the Lord a new song, alleluia; for the Lord has done wondrous deeds, alleluia; in the sight of the nations He has revealed His justice: alleluia, alleluia, alleluia. Ps. 97, 1. His right hand has won victory for Him, His holy arm. *V.* Glory be.

Prayer: O God, You make the minds of the faithful to be of one will; grant to Your people to love that which You command, and to desire that which You promise; that amidst the changes of this world, our hearts may be fixed where there are true joys.

Epistle: James 1, 17-21. Beloved: Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of Lights, with Whom there is no change, nor shadow of alteration. Of His own will He has begotten us by the word of truth, that we might be, as it were, the first-fruits of His creatures. You know this, my beloved brethren. But let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, and slow to wrath. For the wrath of man does not work the justice of God. Therefore, casting aside all uncleanness and abundance of malice, with meekness receive the ingrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* Ps. 117, 16. The right hand of the Lord has struck with power; the right hand of the Lord has exalted me. Alleluia. *V.* Rom. 6, 9. Christ, having risen from the dead, dies now no more; death shall no longer have dominion over Him. Alleluia.

Gospel: John 16, 5-14. At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: "I am going to Him Who sent Me, and no one of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?' But because I have spoken to you these things, sorrow has filled your heart. But I speak the truth to you; it is expedient for you that I depart. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. And when He has come He will convict the world of sin, and of justice, and of judgment: of sin, because they do not believe in Me; of justice, because I go to the Father, and you will see Me no more; and of judgment, because the prince of this world has already been judged. Many things yet I have to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. But when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will teach you all the truth. For He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He will hear He will speak, and the things that are to come He will declare to you. He will glorify Me, because He will receive of what is Mine and declare it to you."

Offertory: Ps. 65, 1. 2. 16. Shout joyfully to God, all you on earth, sing praise to the glory of His name; hear now, all you who fear God, while I declare what the Lord has done for me. Alleluia.

Secret: O God, by the adorable Communion of this sacrifice You make us partakers in the one Supreme Godhead; grant, we beseech You, that even as we recognize Your truth, so we may attain to it by a worthy life.

Communion: John 16, 8. When the Paraclete has come, the Spirit of truth, He will convict the world of sin, and of justice, and of judgment, alleluia, alleluia.

Postcommunion: Be with us, O Lord, our God: that by these mysteries which we have faithfully received, we may both be purified from vice, and delivered from all dangers.
