Fifth Sunday after Easter

Introit: Isa. 48, 20. Declare the word of joy, and let it be heard, alleluia: declare it even to the ends of the earth; the Lord has delivered His people: alleluia, alleluia. Ps. 65, 1. 2. Shout joyfully to God, all you on earth, sing praise to the glory of His name; proclaim His glorious praise.

Prayer: O God, from Whom all good things proceed, grant to Your suppliants, that by Your inspiration we may think those things that are right, and under Your guidance perform them.

Epistle: James 1, 22-27. Beloved: Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like a man looking at his natural face in a mirror: for he looks at himself and goes away, and presently he forgets what kind of man he is. But he who has looked carefully into the perfect law of liberty and has remained in it, not becoming a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, shall be blessed in his deed. And if anyone thinks himself to be religious, not restraining his tongue but deceiving his own heart, that man's religion is vain. Religion pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to give aid to orphans and widows in their tribulation, and to keep oneself unspotted from this world.

Alleluia, alleluia. V. Christ is risen, and has shone upon us, whom He redeemed with His Blood. Alleluia. V. John 16, 28. I came forth from the Father, and have come into the world. Again I leave the world, and go to the Father. Alleluia.

Gospel: John 16, 23-30. At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: "Amen, amen, I say to you, if you ask the Father anything in My name, He will give it to you. Hitherto you have not asked anything in My name. Ask, and you shall receive, that your joy may be full. These things I have spoken to you in parables. The hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in parables, but will speak to you plainly of the Father. In that day you shall ask in My name; and I do not say to you that I will ask the Father for you, for the Father Himself loves you because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God. I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again I leave the world and go to the Father." His disciples said to Him, "Behold, now You speak plainly, and utter no parable. Now we know that You know all things, and do not need that anyone should question You. For this reason we believe that You came forth from God."

Offertory: Ps. 65, 8.9. 20. Bless the Lord our God, you peoples, loudly sound His praise; He has given life to my soul, and has not let my feet slip. Blessed be the Lord, Who refused me not my prayer, or His kindness. Alleluia.

Secret: Accept we beseech You, O Lord, the prayers of the faithful with the offerings of these sacrifices, that by these services of pious devotion we may pass to heavenly glory.

Communion: Ps. 95, 2. Sing to the Lord, alleluia; sing to the Lord; bless His name; announce His salvation, day after day, alleluia, alleluia.

Postcommunion: O Lord, grant us who have been satisfied with the strength of the heavenly table, both to desire those things which are right and to obtain what we desire.

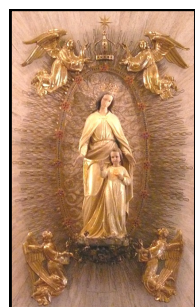
