EASTER SUNDAY

Introit: *Psalm 138: 18, 5, 6.* I am risen, and am still with Thee, alleluia: Thou hast laid Thy hand upon Me, alleluia: Thy knowledge is become wonderful, alleluia, alleluia. **Ps. 138, 1, 2.** Lord, Thou hast proved Me, and known Me: Thou hast known My sitting down, and My rising up. *V.* Glory.

Collect: O God, Who, this day by Thine only-begotten Son, vanquishing death, hast unlocked for us the gate of eternity, help us to attain the desires to which Thou hast led us by Thine inspirations. Through the same.

Epistle: *I Corinthians 5: 7, 8.* Brethren, purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new paste, as you are unleavened: for Christ our pasch is sacrificed. Therefore, let us feast, not with the old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Gradual: *Psalm 117: 24, 1.* This is the day which the Lord hath made: Let us be glad and rejoice therein. *V.* Give praise to the Lord, for He is good: for His mercy endureth forever. Alleluia, alleluia. *V.* *I Corinthians 5: 7.* Christ our pasch is sacrificed.

Gospel: *St. Mark 16: 1-7.* At that time, Mary Magdalen, and Mary, the mother of James, and Salome bought sweet spices, that coming they might anoint Jesus. And very early in the morning, the first day of the week, they come to the sepulchre, the sun being now risen; and they said one to another, Who shall roll back the stone from the door of the sepulchre? And looking, they saw the stone rolled back: for it was very great. And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed with a white robe, and they were astonished: who saith to them, Be not affrighted; you seek Jesus of Nazareth, Who was crucified: He is risen, He is not here; behold the place where they laid Him: but go, tell His disciples, and Peter, that He goeth before you into Galilee: there you shall see Him, as He told you.

Offertory: *Psalm 75: 9, 10.* The earth trembled and was still, when God arose in judgment. Alleluia.

Secret: Receive, we beseech Thee, O Lord, the prayers of Thy people with the offerings of sacrifices, that the things begun in the paschal mysteries may, by Thy operation, avail us for a healing remedy unto life everlasting. Through our Lord.

Communion: *I Corinthians 5: 7, 8.* Christ, our pasch is immolated, alleluia: therefore let us feast in the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia.

Postcommunion: Pour upon us, O Lord, the spirit of Thy love, to make us of one mind, whom, by Thy tender mercy, Thou hast filled with the paschal sacrament. Through our Lord.

THE ANGELUS AND THE REGINA CAELI

Throughout the year, we recite the Angelus at 6:00 AM, noon, and 6:00 PM, or as close to these times as is practicable. From Holy Thursday through Holy Saturday, the recitation of this prayer is suspended, and the church bells are not rung. At the Easter Vigil the bells ring once more, and from this time through the Octave of Pentecost, the Angelus is replaced by the Regina Caeli:

Regina caeli, laetare, alleluia:

R. Quia quem meruisti portare, alleluia,

Resurrexit, sicut dixit, alleluia,

R. Ora pro nobis Deum, alleluia.

Gaude et laetare, Virgo Maria, alleluia.

R. Quia surrexit Dominus vere, alleluia.

Oremus.

Deus, qui per resurrectionem Filii tui, Domini nostri Jesu Christi, mundum laetificare dignatus es:

praesta, quasumus, ut per ejus Genitricem Virginem Mariam, perpetuae capiamus gaudia vitae. Per eundem Christum Dominum nostrum.

R. Amen.

Queen of Heaven, rejoice. Alleluia.

For He, whom thou didst merit to bear, Alleluia.

Is risen as He said. Alleluia.

Pray for us to God. Alleluia.

V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary. Alleluia.

R. Because the Lord is truly risen, Alleluia.

O God, Who by the Resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, didst vouchsafe to make glad the whole world, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may attain the joys of eternal life. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.
