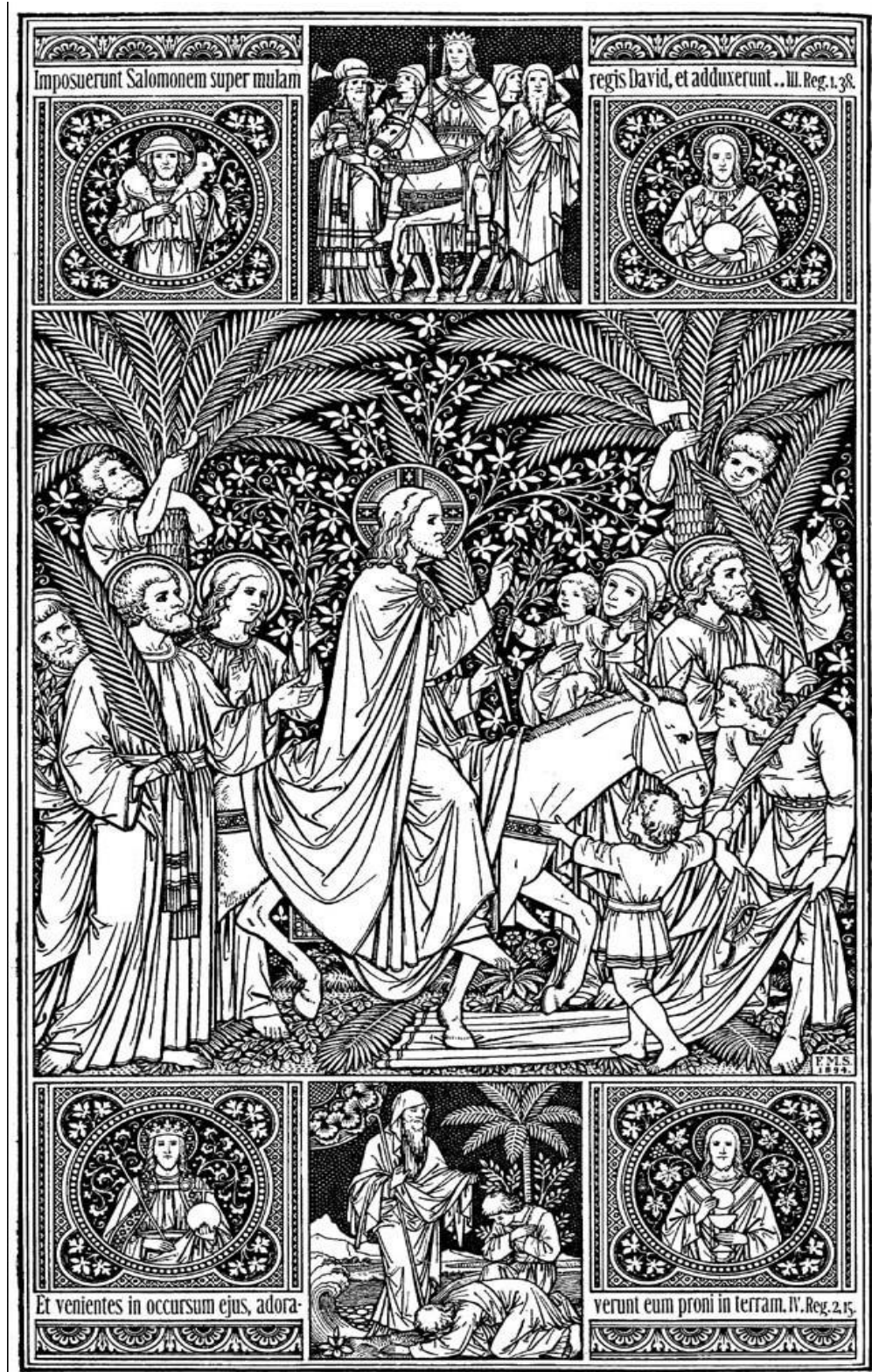

Children may make their first Confession to Canon Huberfeld anytime from April 18 through 29.

ALL First Communicants must be present at the rehearsal on Sunday, April 29 at 12:00 noon.

Those who will be making their First Holy Communion need to furnish a photocopy of their Baptismal Certificate.

Please submit this to the Oratory office before Easter Sunday, April 1.

Parents who do not send their child to Canon Huberfeld's Level 1 Catechism Class but who would nevertheless like their child to make his first Holy Communion on May 6 are kindly asked to contact the Oratory office as soon as possible. They should be preparing their child at home using The New St. Joseph First Communion Catechism, available in Nancy Heideman's shop.

THE ANGELUS AND THE REGINA CAELI

Throughout the year, we recite the Angelus at 6:00 AM, noon, and 6:00 PM, or as close to these times as is practicable. From Holy Thursday through Holy Saturday, the recitation of this prayer is suspended, and the church bells are not rung. At the Easter Vigil the bells ring once more, and from this time through the Octave of Pentecost, the Angelus is replaced by the Regina Caeli:

Regina caeli, lætare, alleluia:
R. Quia quem meruisti portare, alleluia,
Resurrexit, sicut dixit, alleluia,
R. Ora pro nobis Deum, alleluia.
Gaude et lætare, Virgo Maria, alleluia.
R. Quia surrexit Dominus vere, alleluia.

Queen of Heaven, rejoice. Alleluia.
For He, whom thou didst merit to bear, Alleluia.
Is risen as He said. Alleluia.
Pray for us to God. Alleluia.
V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary. Alleluia.
R. Because the Lord is truly risen, Alleluia.
