## SOVEREIGN PRIEST

### FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

**Introit:** *Psalm 97: 1, 2.* Sing ye to the Lord a new canticle, alleluia; for the Lord hath done wonderful things, alleluia; He hath revealed His justice in the sight of the gentiles, alleluia, alleluia. *Ps. 97: 1.* His right hand hath wrought for Him salvation: and His arm is holy. Glory be. Sing ye to the Lord.

**Collect:** O God, Who dost make the minds of the faithful to be of one accord, grant Thy peoples that they may love what Thou commandest and desire what Thou dost promise, so that, amid the changing things of this world, our hearts may be set where true joys abide. Through our Lord.

**For the Pope:** O God, the Shepherd and Ruler of all the faithful, look down favorably upon Thy servant Francis, whom Thou hast been pleased to appoint pastor over Thy Church; grant, we beseech Thee, that he may benefit both by word and example those over whom he is set, and thus attain unto life eternal, together with the flock committed to his care. Through our Lord.

**Epistle:** *I James 1: 17-21.* Dearly beloved, Every best gift, and every perfect gift is from above; coming down from the Father of lights, with Whom there is no change, nor shadow of alteration. For of His own will hath He begotten us by the word of truth, that we might be some beginning of His creatures. You know, my dearest brethren; and let every man be swift to hear, but slow to speak, and slow to anger. For the anger of man worketh not the justice of God. Wherefore, casting away all uncleanness, and abundance of naughtiness, with meekness receive the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

**Alleluia:** Alleluia, alleluia. *Psalm 117: 16.* The right hand of the Lord hath wrought power; the right hand of the Lord hath exalted me. Alleluia. *Romans 6: 9.* Christ, rising from the dead, now dieth not; death shall no more have dominion over Him. Alleluia.

**Gospel:** *St. John 16: 5-14.* At that time Jesus said to His disciples, I go to Him that sent Me; and none of you asketh Me, Whither goest Thou? But because I have spoken these things to you, sorrow hath filled your heart. But I tell you the truth: it is expedient to you that I go; for if I go not, the Paraclete will not come to you, but if I go, I will send Him to you. And when He is come, He will convince the world of sin, and of justice, and of judgment. Of sin, because they believed not in Me; and of justice, because I go to the Father, and you shall see Me no longer; and of judgment, because the prince of this world is already judged. I have yet many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now; but when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will teach you all truth; for He shall not speak of Himself; but what things soever He shall hear, He shall speak, and the things that are to come He shall show you. He shall glorify Me because He shall receive of Mine, and shall show it to you.

**Offertory:** *Psalm 65: 1, 2, 16.* Shout with joy to God, all the earth, sing ye a psalm to His name: come, and hear, and I will tell you, all you that fear God, what great things the Lord hath done for my soul, alleluia.

**Secret:** O God, Who, through the holy relationship of this sacrament, hast made us partakers of one supreme divinity, grant, we beseech Thee, that, as we know Thy truth, so we may follow it with worthy behaviour. Through our Lord.

**For the Pope:** We beseech Thee, O Lord, that Thou mayest be appeased by the gifts we offer, and govern by Thy continual protection Thy servant Francis, whom Thou hast been pleased to appoint pastor over Thy Church. Through our Lord.
