CHRISTUS MANSIONEM BENEDICAT

Introit: Malachi 3, 1. Behold the Lord the Ruler is come: and a kingdom in His hand, and power and dominion. **Psalm 71, 1.** Give to the king thy judgment, O God: and to the king's son Thy justice. V. Glory.

Collect: O God, Who by the guidance of a star didst this day reveal Thine only-begotten Son to the Gentiles, mercifully grant that we, who know Thee now by faith, may be so led as to behold with our eyes the beauty of Thy majesty. Through the same.

Epistle: Isaias 60, 1-6. Arise, be enlightened, O Jerusalem; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. For behold darkness shall cover the earth, and a mist the people; but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and His glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall walk in thy light, and kings in the brightness of thy rising. Lift up thy eyes round about, and see; all these are gathered together, they are come to thee: thy sons shall come from afar, and thy daughters shall rise up at thy side. Then shalt thou see, and abound, and thy heart shall wonder and be enlarged, when the multitude of the sea shall be converted to thee, the strength of the Gentiles shall come to thee. The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Madian and Ephraim; all they from Saba shall come, bringing gold and frankincense, and showing forth praise to the Lord.

Gradual: Isaias 60, 1. All they from Saba shall come, bringing gold and frankincense, and showing forth praise to the Lord. V. Arise and be enlightened, O Jerusalem, for the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. Alleluia, Alleluia. **V. Matt. 2, 2.** We have seen His star in the east: and are come with gifts to adore the Lord. Alleluia.

Gospel: Matthew 2, 1-12. When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Juda, in the days of King Herod, behold there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem; saying, Where is He that is born king of the Jews? for we have seen His star in the east, and are come to adore Him. And King Herod, hearing this, was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. And assembling together all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, he inquired of them where Christ should be born. But they said to him: In Bethlehem of Juda; for so it is written by the prophet: And thou Bethlehem, the land of Juda, art not the least among the princes of Juda; for out of thee shall come forth the ruler that shall rule my people Israel. Then Herod privately calling the wise men, learned diligently of them the time of the star which appeared to them; and sending them into Bethlehem, said, Go and diligently inquire after the child, and when you have found Him bring me word again, that I also may come and adore Him. Who having heard the king, went their way; and behold the star which they had seen in the east went before them, until it came and stood over where the child was. And seeing the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy. And entering into the house, they found the child with Mary His mother (*here all kneel down*), and falling down they adored Him. And opening their treasures, they offered Him gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having received an answer in sleep that they should not return to Herod, they went back another way into their own country.

Offertory: Psalm 71, 10, 11. The kings of Tharsis and the islands shall offer presents: the kings of the Arabians and of Saba shall bring gifts: and all kings of the earth shall adore Him; all nations shall serve Him.

Secret: Favorably regard the gifts of Thy Church, O Lord, wherein no longer gold is offered, nor frankincense, nor myrrh, but He who by these gifts is signified is become our sacrifice and our food, Jesus Christ, our Lord, Who with Thee.

Communion: Matthew 2, 2. We have seen His star in the east, and are come with gifts to adore the Lord.

Postcommunion: Grant, we beseech Thee, O Almighty God, by the understanding of hearts made pure we may comprehend that which by solemn rite we celebrate. Through our Lord.

SOLEMN PUBLICATION OF THE DATE OF EASTER AND OTHER MOVEABLE FEASTS

Epiphany is the last principal feast before the beginning of the Easter cycle. On this day, after the Gospel on the most important Mass of the day, there is the Solemn Publication of the Date of Easter and other main moveable feasts.

This chant is called by its first word "Noveritis", and its melody uses the same tune as the "Exultet" of the Easter Vigil, which gives a foretaste of the Easter joy to this publication. Dom Prosper Guéranger explains:

"This custom, which dates from the earliest ages of the Church, shows both the mysterious connection which unites the great Solemnities of the year one with another, and the importance the Faithful ought to attach to the celebration of that which is the greatest of all, and the center of all Religion. After having honored the King of the universe on the Epiphany, we shall have to celebrate him on the day which is now announced to us, as the conqueror of death."

Translation of the "Noveritis" for the Year of Grace 2019:

"Know, dearly beloved Brethren, that by the mercy of God, as we have been rejoicing in the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so also do we announce unto you the joy of the Resurrection of the same our Savior. Septuagesima Sunday will be on the 17th day of February. Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the fast of most holy Lent will be on the 6th day of March. On the 21st of April we shall celebrate with joy the holy Pasch of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ will be on the 30th of May. The Feast of Pentecost on the 9th day of June. The Feast of Corpus Christi on the 20th of the same month. On the 1st of December will occur the first Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom are honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen."
