### INSTITUTE TO CELEBRATE LIVE TELEVISED MASS

On **Sunday, September 14th**, members of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest will celebrate a Solemn High Mass at Our Lady of the Angels Monastery of the Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration in Hanceville, Alabama. The conventional Mass will be broadcast live by EWTN, the Global Catholic Network, to a worldwide audience of 140 million homes, through TV, radio, and live streaming video online.

**September 14th marks the first anniversary of the implementation of Pope Benedict XVI's *motu proprio* "Summorum Pontificum".** The Solemn High Mass will be *in commemoration of, and thanksgiving for, this pivotal document of His Holiness*, which confirms that the Latin Rite in its ancient form as presented in the 1962 liturgical books of the Roman Catholic Church was never abrogated and is available to all priests and all faithful who desire it.

**The live broadcast from Our Lady of the Angels Monastery will take place at 8:00 AM Eastern Time USA, 14:00 Central European Time, 12:00 UTC.**

## FROM THE DESK OF THE RECTOR

---

My Dear Faithful,

September 14th marks the first anniversary of the implementation of Pope Benedict XVI's *motu proprio* "Summorum Pontificum". The Holy Father's personal initiative and continued effort in promoting the perennial Roman Rite in its classical form has set free a veritable avalanche. The churches and parishes where the Classical Roman Rite is offered are legion. The interest of clergy and laity alike is anything else but on the decline.

Sadly we have also witnessed that some people have an always negative attitude toward authority: it is never good enough; it is never done fast enough. May they keep shaking their heads until they find the hair in the soup. We for our part, are mindful of and deeply thankful for the great charity and courage that animated our Holy Father when he published *motu proprio* (of his own accord) the document "Summorum Pontificum".

Among many other noteworthy things mentioned in the document, Benedict XVI confirmed that the Traditional Latin Mass as presented in the 1962 liturgical books was never abrogated. The Divine Liturgy is our "family treasure". Throughout the centuries it grew organically, enriched itself under the influence of sound Catholic theology and devotion, under the watchful eye of Divine Providence. What belonged to all was given back to all by the Father of all, Benedict XVI. Deo gratias!

No longer are the Traditional Latin Mass, the clergy and faithful who cherish it ostracized. It has become completely normal to celebrate it wherever we go. Through the growing interest also among the clergy more and more faithful have come to enjoy the riches and beauties of the Traditional rite, which has become easily accessible in many areas. It has been heard of at least in one diocesan seminary where the Traditional Mass is celebrated regularly and the young seminarians are prepared to celebrate it. I am not betraying a secret if I tell you that the number of diocesan bishops who cherish the traditional Liturgy is increasing. From all the Holy Father has done so far for the restoration of the Classical Roman Rite His deep love for it is also obvious.

Please continue to keep our Holy Father in your continuous prayers. We must be so thankful for being truly a Father to us and a Good Shepherd to his flock. May God reward him and bless his work and prayer with an abundant harvest of souls!
