Dear Faithful,

The Institute of Christ the King has been asked by the Board of Directors of St. Anthony's to assume full responsibility of the Chapel including the property and administration. We are very honored by this confidence and the good collaboration and support we have received from all here at St. Anthony's. We fully agree that it is prudent to ask all the faithful to participate in a ballot before the transition takes place.

With the planned transition, though, St. Anthony's Chapel will not change. The Institute of Christ the King and the Board of Directors will sign an agreement that will ascertain the full continuation of the present liturgical and doctrinal orientation. The property will remain in the use of the Chapel, Reverend Father Munkelt will stay in Residence and continue to serve, and the Institute of Christ the King will staff the Chapel on a long term basis. In addition, the Provincial Bursar of the Institute will regularly assist Reverend Father Hellmann with the budget and a yearly financial report for the Chapel. Property and assets will be used to benefit St. Anthony's Chapel and the faithful. Should you have further questions, please do not hesitate to approach your Rector.

The Institute of Christ the King exclusively offers the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and all other Sacraments in the Traditional Form of the Latin Rite. Our Priests are trained in the whole Tradition of Holy Mother Church in Doctrine, Liturgy and Catholic life.
