Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary

TODAY: External Solemnity

Oct 7, Feast Day: 5:30pm Low Mass

In 622, Mohammed set out from Medina to conquer the Christian world for Allah by force and arms. In 100 years, they had taken from the Christians Jerusalem, Antioch, Alexandria, Hippo, Tunis, Carthage, Spain, and southern France. The Muslim expulsion from France was quick but Spain took 750 years to win back. For the most part, Europe was spared the rule of the Crescent. But following the fall of the Byzantine Empire in 1453, the Ottoman Turks were ready to make an attack on the mainland of Western Europe in hatred of the Christian Faith of the Crusaders. Pope St. Pius V called the Holy League to defend Christendom and called on monasteries, convents, and all the faithful to do penance and pray the Rosary for Mary's protection as a great naval battle was preparing at Lepanto. On October 7th, 1571, the Holy League stupendously defeated the Ottoman Turks and 15,000 Christian slaves were set free from the Ottoman galleys. Pope St. Pius V was granted a vision of the Christian victory and gave thanks to Mary. A special feast was instituted on this day in honor of Our Lady as the feast of "Our Lady of Victory" which would later become "Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary" as it was through the Rosary that the victory was obtained.

Thought from St. Francis de Sales:



Let us kiss our Savior, Who grants us so many delights. Now to kiss the Savior is to obey Him, keep His commandments, do His will and follow His desires; in brief, to embrace Him with tender obedience and fidelity. Therefore, whenever we receive any spiritual consolation, on that very day we must be more diligent in doing good and humbling ourselves. (*INT. Part IV, Ch. 13; p. 324*)

From the Introduction to the Apostolic Letter **ROSARIUM VIRGINIS MARIAE** OF THE SUPREME PONTIFF JOHN PAUL II TO THE BISHOPS, CLERGY AND FAITHFUL ON THE MOST HOLY ROSARY

1. The Rosary of the Virgin Mary, which gradually took form in the second millennium under the guidance of the Spirit of God, is a prayer loved by countless Saints and encouraged by the Magisterium. Simple yet profound, it still remains, at the dawn of this third millennium, a prayer of great significance, destined to bring forth a harvest of holiness. It blends easily into the spiritual journey of the Christian life, which, after two thousand years, has lost none of the freshness of its beginnings and feels drawn by the Spirit of God to "set out into the deep" (*duc in altum!*) in order once more to proclaim, and even cry out, before the world that Jesus Christ is Lord and Savior, "the way, and the truth and the life" (Jn 14:6), "the goal of human history and the point on which the desires of history and civilization turn".

2. The Rosary, though clearly Marian in character, is at heart a Christocentric prayer. In the sobriety of its elements, it has all the *depth of the Gospel message in its entirety*, of which it can be said to be a compendium. It is a beautiful echo of the most beautiful prayer of Mary, her perennial *Magnificat* for the work of the redemptive Incarnation which began in her virginal womb. With the Rosary, the Christian people *sits at the school of Mary* and is led to contemplate the beauty on the face of Christ and to experience the depths of His love. Through the Rosary the faithful receive abundant grace, as though from the very hands of the Mother of the Redeemer.

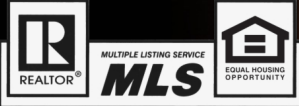






POST - COMMUNION PRAYER

WRITTEN BY ST. THOMAS AQUINAS
