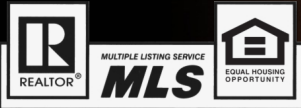

Novena in Preparation for the Feast of Our Lord's Nativity

Prayer to the Infant King

O Divine Infant Jesus, I have recourse to Thee. Please, through Thy Blessed Mother, assist me in this necessity ...*mention intention...*, because I firmly believe that Thy Divinity can help me. I hope with confidence to obtain Thy holy grace. I love Thee with all my heart and with all the strength of my soul. I repent sincerely of my sins and I beg Thee, O Good Jesus, to grant me the strength to triumph over them. I resolve never more to offend Thee and I come to offer myself to Thee with the intention of enduring everything rather than to displease Thee. Henceforth, I desire to serve Thee with fidelity and, for the love of Thee, O Divine Infant, I will love my neighbor as myself.

All-powerful Infant, O Jesus, I implore Thee again, assist me in this need. Grant me the grace of possessing Thee eternally with Mary and Joseph and of adoring Thee with the angels in the Heavenly Court. Amen.

The Great O's

December 17th - O Wisdom, * which camest out of the mouth of the Most High, and reachest from one end to another, mightily and sweetly ordering all things: Come and teach us the way of prudence.

December 18th - O Adonai, * and Leader of the house of Israel, who appearedst in the Bush to Moses in a flame of fire, and gavest him the Law of Sinai: Come and redeem us with an outstretched arm.

December 19th - O Root of Jesse, * which standest for an ensign of the people, at whom kings shall shut their mouths, to whom the Gentiles shall seek: Come and deliver us, and tarry not.

December 20th - O Key of David, * and Sceptre of the house of Israel; that openest and no man shutteth, and shuttest and no man openeth: Come and bring the prisoners out of the prison-house, them that sit in darkness and the shadow of death.

December 21st - O Dayspring, * Brightness of Light Everlasting, and Sun of Righteousness: Come and enlighten them that sit in darkness and the shadow of death.

December 22nd - O King of the Nations, * and their Desire; the Cornerstone who maketh both one: Come and save mankind, whom thou formedst of clay.

December 23rd - O Emmanuel, * our King and Lawgiver, the Desire of all nations and their Salvation: Come and save us, O Lord our God.

Each day of the Novena, after the corresponding "O" Antiphon:

V. Rorate, cæli, desuper, et nubes pluant justum.

R. Aperiatur terra, et germinet Salvatorem.

During 3rd Week of Advent:

Oremus.

Aurem tuam, quæsumus, Dómine, précibus nostris accommoda: et mentis nostræ ténebras grátia tuæ visitationis illústra: Qui vivis et regnas in sæcula sæculórum. R. Amen.

During 4th Week of Advent:

Oremus.

Excita, quæsumus, Dómine, poténtiam tuam, et veni: et magna nobis virtúte succurre; ut per auxiliúm grátia tuæ, quod nostra peccáta præpédiunt, indulgéntia tuæ propitiationis accéleret: Qui vivis et regnas in sæcula sæculórum. R. Amen.

Each day of the Novena, after the corresponding "O" Antiphon:

V. Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness.

R. Let the earth open, and bring forth a Savior.

During 3rd Week of Advent:

Let us pray.

Incline thine ear, we beseech thee, O Lord, to our prayers: and make bright the darkness of our minds by the grace of thy visitation. Who livest and reignest, world without end. R. Amen.

During 4th Week of Advent:

Let us pray.

Stir up, we beseech thee, O Lord, thy power, and come; make haste to our aid with thy great might; that, by the help of thy grace, that which is hindered by our sins may be hastened by thy merciful forgiveness. Who livest and reignest, world without end. R. Amen.
