- ◆ Go to Confession (up to 8 days before/after)
- ◆ Receive Holy Communion,
- ◆ Say five decades of the Rosary, and
- ◆ Keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the 15 mysteries of the Rosary.'

### 5 First Saturdays in reparation for

1. Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception of Mary.
2. Blasphemies against her Perpetual Virginity.
3. Blasphemies against her Divine Maternity, refusing at the same time to recognize her as the Mother of men.
4. The blasphemies of those who publicly seek to sow in the hearts of children indifference, scorn, or even hatred of the Immaculate Mother.

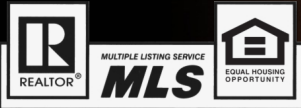
