#### Dear Faithful,

Today is the 1st Sunday of Lent. In the Gospel, Our Lord repels the three temptations of the devil which represent the three sources of temptation for us: the world, the devil, and the flesh, which we must fight against to overcome. The Church offers us three remedies to use in our battle against these enemies: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We need to employ all of them to have a successful Lent.
