Word from the Vice-Rector

Dear Faithful,

It is your generous support that makes our mission here at the Shrine possible. Without it, we could not sustain our apostolic work in the service of your souls. We are blessed to have many generous benefactors from around the United States who selflessly support the reconstruction and restoration work of the Shrine church building, a monumental task. The Holy Family House, however, which has become our home in the past year and a half, benefits primarily you the faithful of the Shrine, and so it is you that we ask to contribute to the upkeep and restoration of that building. Different expenses we have to cover include the heating and cooling of the building (no small matter!), especially the chapel, monthly electricity and water bills, and the restoration of the building itself. Accomplished restoration includes the chapel and the social hall, with other rooms touched up to accommodate various activities. However, much remains to be done, and some of it is urgent. A part of the roof leaks and water has infiltrated and damaged the walls and ceilings on multiple floors. We have to repair this section of the roof soon to prevent future damage. We also want to air condition the social hall, repair the floor in the sewing rooms, improve the conference room, etc. This can only be done with your help! Please prayerfully consider making a regular donation to the Holy Family House fund by using the green envelopes that you can find in your pews or in the vestibule. The work we are accomplishing physically is a good symbol of the work God is accomplishing through us spiritually in the restoration of our Christian society. May God reward your generosity!
