## Blessed is the King who comes...

"Just as the Lord entered the Holy City that day on a donkey," said Benedict XVI, "so too the Church saw him coming again and again in the humble form of bread and wine."

Therefore the scene of Palm Sunday is repeated in some way in our own life.

Jesus comes to the city of our soul in the humble guise of ordinary life: in the simplicity of the sacraments; or in

gentle suggestions, like these: Fulfill your duty punctually; smile at whoever needs cheering up, even though there is sorrow in your soul; devote the necessary time to prayer, without haggling; go to the help of anyone who looks for you; practice justice and go beyond it with the grace of charity; forgive and/or ask for forgiveness.

We can also consider the significance of the donkey in this scene: There are hundreds of animals more beautiful, more deft and strong. But it was a donkey Christ chose when He presented Himself to the people as king in response to their acclamation.

For Jesus has no time for calculations, for astuteness, for the cruelty of cold hearts, for attractive but empty beauty. What He likes is the cheerfulness of a young heart, a simple step, a natural voice, clear eyes, attention to His affectionate word of advice. That is how He reigns in the soul.

Whoever welcomes Jesus with humility and simplicity can bring Him everywhere.

Have a beautiful Holy Week! Take courage.






Holy Week Liturgy Announcement

In 2018 permission was received from the Pontifical Commission *Ecclesia Dei* in Rome to celebrate the Liturgy of Holy Week according to the liturgical norms in use before changes were made mid-20th century. All the apostolates of the Institute of Christ the King are included with other *Ecclesia Dei* communities in this indult.

This older form of the Ritual and its prayers offer a spirituality that is especially rich and edifying in total conformity with the spirit of the Roman Missal.

For the benefit of the faithful, booklets with English translations and explanations are available at the entrance to the church. These booklets will be used on Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil.



APRIL Month of the Holy Eucharist

The month of April is traditionally dedicated to devotion to Jesus in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The Catholic Church teaches that the Blessed Sacrament is the real and living presence of Christ; His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity received into our souls with every reception of Holy Communion. Our Eucharistic Lord is the source and summit of our Christian life, the ultimate proof of His infinite love for us.
