### Our Lord Weeps Over Jerusalem

It is quite touching to see our Lord weeping in today's Gospel. It is good for us to look at our Lord and to consider His human nature, His emotions and His feelings. It shows how much God loves us and that He wants our salvation. The tears of Jesus are the visible proof that God sincerely desires our salvation.

Jerusalem is the figure of our soul. Our soul is supposed to be a city of peace, and the great lesson of today is simply to recognize the time of the visitation of God.

In one of his many sermons, Pope Saint Gregory the Great reminds us that even though we have accepted the Catholic faith, there is a danger that the temple of our soul may become a figurative den of thieves and that many of us could face the same destruction as Jerusalem. God expects our soul to be a font of prayers and ever to be thirsting for the knowledge of Him. He expects our will to conform to His will. He expects us to love our neighbor as He loves us and them. We must not make the mistake of the Jews who thought that God would always be sending His help and protection to them.

The time of our visitation is now. Jesus has admitted us to His kingdom through baptism; He gives us the opportunity to confess our sins, to stand by His cross in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and to receive Holy Communion. As Saint Paul says, "God is faithful and He will not tempt us beyond our strength", but He does expect us to do our part.

## St. Peter in Chains

Tuesday, August 1 - 6:00 p.m. Mass

To please the enemies of the Christians, Herod Agrippa had put St. James to death, and now he planned to do the same to St. Peter, the Head of the Church. Once he had him in prison, he set a heavy guard about him to make sure he would not escape. But all

the Christians of Jerusalem were begging the Lord to save St. Peter, and their prayers were answered. The night before he was to be condemned, St. Peter was peacefully sleeping in his prison cell between his two guards bound tightly by two chains. He was unafraid of death and ready to do God's will. Suddenly an angel appeared and tapped him on the side to awaken him. He told him to get up at once, put on his cloak and sandals and follow him. At the same moment, both the chains fell from his hands! Out the two went, past two sets of guards, to the gate. This iron gate opened to them by itself and the angel led St. Peter out to the street. Then he disappeared. Up to then, Peter had thought he might be dreaming, but now he knew that God had really sent an angel to free him! What joy and gratitude filled his heart! At once, the Apostle went to the home of Mary, St. Mark's mother, where many Christians were praying for his safety. He knocked at the door and a young woman named Rhoda came to ask who it was, without opening the door. When she heard St. Peter's voice, she ran joyfully to tell the others. They, however, could not believe the news. "It must be his angel," they said when she kept insisting. Meanwhile St. Peter knocked again. At last they let him in, and their happiness was immense when they saw it was truly St. Peter himself! He told them how the angel had freed him, and altogether they blessed and thanked the Lord. The feast day is August 1st.

## Fatima and the Immaculate Heart of Mary The Five First Saturdays Devotion

*The devotion of the Five First Saturdays,  
comes to us straight from heaven!*

In 1917 The Blessed Mother appeared six times to three little shepherds, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta at Fatima, Portugal. She asked for conversion of life and the recitation of the Rosary so the world could have peace.



In the second apparition of Fatima, Our Lady showed the seers, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta, her heart encircled by thorns. Later, on December 10, 1925, in a private apparition to Sister Lucia, she asked for the devotion of reparation of the Five First Saturdays.

The Blessed Mother appeared alongside the Child Jesus who stood over a luminous cloud. Our Lady rested one hand on the Child's shoulder while she held on the other hand a heart pierced with thorns.

The Child said, "Have pity on the Heart of your Most Holy Mother which is covered with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment with no one to extract them with an act of reparation."

***Our Lady expressed her request in the following words;***

"See, my daughter, My Heart surrounded with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce me at every moment with blasphemies and ingratitude. You, at least, make sure to console me and announce that all those who for five months, on the first Saturdays, go to Confession, receive Communion, say five decades of the Rosary and keep me company for 15 minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to Me, I promise to assist them at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation of their souls."
