The entire law is summarized in these two general principles: the love of God and the love of neighbor.



This teaching of Our Savior is given to us with authority and in this last part of the Gospel, Jesus makes it understandable for those who not only refuse to acknowledge Him as the Son of David, but that He is also the only Son of God, born of an eternal and divine birth.

When He teaches, He engages His divine authority.

The commandment of love is therefore not an option. It is given to us by Jesus revealing His divinity.


SEPTEMBER - MONTH OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

Dedication of St. Michael the Archangel

Friday, September 29 6:00 p.m. Mass

St. Michael's name - *Quis ut Deus* or **Who is Like God** --this was the war-cry of the good angels in the battle fought in heaven against the enemy and his followers.

Four times his name is recorded in Scripture:



Daniel 12, the Angel speaking of the end of the world and the Antichrist says: "At that time shall Michael rise up, the great prince, who standeth for the children of thy people."

Catholic Epistle of St. Jude: "When Michael the Archangel, disputing with the devil, contended about the body of Moses," etc.

Apocalypse 12:7, "And there was a great battle in heaven, Michael and his angels fought with the dragon." St. John speaks here of the great conflict at the end of time.

Following these Scriptural passages then, Christian tradition assigns to St. Michael four functions:

- * To fight against Satan.
- * To rescue the souls of the faithful from the power of the enemy, especially at the hour of death.
- * To be the champion of God's people, the Jews in the Old Law, the Christians in the New Testament, making him, therefore, patron of the Church.
- * To call away from the Earth men's souls bringing them to judgment.


