"My Kingdom is not of this world"



In today's Gospel we contemplate the great difference between Jesus and Pilate.

Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Pilate and the Jewish leaders are thinking in terms of an earthly king with political power and control of an army to enforce his will - someone like Caesar in Rome.

Jesus flatly rejects the notion of being an earthly king, but He still claims to be a king - a King of Truth. He said, "Yes, I am a king; I was born for this; I came into the world to bear witness to the truth; all on the side of truth listen to my voice".

He rules over the hearts of men by faith, hope and charity. So Jesus Christ is king on two levels: First, by His divinity He is our Creator and Redeemer; second, by His humanity He saved us by His suffering and death on the cross.

Jesus wants you and me, and every human person, to be a member of His kingdom. We enter it by believing in His word, by loving Him and by placing our hope in Him.

We must remember that Jesus is a different kind of King, that He is a King of Hearts. He rules us through truth and love, not by force and intimidation.

The cross is Christ's royal throne; from the cross He stretches out His arms to draw all men to Himself, and from the cross He rules over them by His love.

For Him to reign over us, we must allow ourselves to be drawn to Him and to be conquered by His love.

LONG LIVE CHRIST THE KING! May God bless you all!

Ordered by Pope Pius XI to be recited on the Feast of Christ the King



Most Sweet Jesus, Redeemer of the human race, look down upon us humbly prostrate before Thine altar. We are Thine, and Thine we wish to be; but to be more surely united to Thee, behold each one of us freely consecrates ourselves today to Thy Most Sacred Heart.

Many indeed have never known Thee; Many too, despising Thy precepts, have rejected Thee. Have mercy on them all, most merciful Jesus, and draw them to Thy Sacred Heart. Be Thou King, O Lord, not only of the faithful children, who have never forsaken Thee, but also of the prodigal children, who have abandoned Thee; Grant that they may quickly return to their Father's house lest they die of wretchedness and hunger.

Be Thou King of those who are deceived by erroneous opinions, or whom discord keeps aloof, and call them back to the harbor of truth and unity of faith, so that there may be but one flock and one Shepherd.

Be Thou King of all those who are still involved in the darkness of idolatry or of Islamism, and refuse not to draw them into the light and kingdom of God. Turn Thine eyes of mercy towards the children of the race, once Thy chosen people: of old they called down upon themselves the Blood of the Savior; may it now descend upon them a laver of redemption and of life.

Grant, O Lord, to Thy Church assurance of freedom and immunity from harm; give peace and order to all nations, and make the earth resound from pole to pole with one cry; praise to the Divine Heart that wrought our salvation; To it be glory and honor forever.

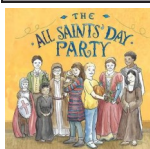
St. Philip Neri Seminary Society

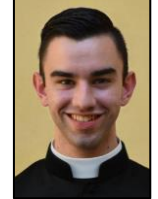

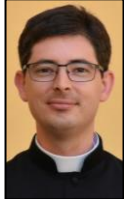


