EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Saturday, January 6 - 9:00 a.m. Mass

Epiphany is one of the oldest Christian feasts and one of the most important. Historically, Epiphany celebrated four things: Jesus' nativity, the Magi's visit to the Holy Family, Jesus' baptism, and Jesus' first miracle at the wedding feast of Cana. Each biblical event is a theophany, or epiphany, a special manifestation of Jesus Christ to mankind. The relationship between these events is beautifully described in this antiphon from the Divine Office:

"This day is the Church joined unto the Heavenly Bridegroom, since Christ hath washed away her sins in Jordan; the wise men hasten with gifts to the marriage supper of the King; and they that sit at meat together make merry with water turned into wine. Alleluia." In the Latin Church the visit of the Three Kings is the primary focus of Epiphany, symbolizing the revelation of Jesus Christ as a light for the Gentile nations and the Savior born for the redemption of all mankind. Epiphany is January 6th, traditionally marking the end of the 12 days of Christmas.

EPIPHANY SCHEDULE

Friday, January 5th (Vigil of the Epiphany)

Confession: 5:00-5:45 p.m.

Mass: 6:00 p.m. followed by the solemn blessing of the Epiphany water and the blessing of the chalk.

Saturday, January 6th (Epiphany)

Confession: 8:30-8:55 a.m.

Mass: 9:00 a.m. followed by the blessing of Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh at the front of the manger.

You can either bring your items to be blessed and returned OR you may leave them as an offering. They will be used for the celebration of the Mass, to help our restoration project or our St. Anthony's fund. Merry Christmas!

Two Chances to Gain Plenary Indulgence on Dec. 31 & Jan. 1

Catholics can gain a Plenary Indulgence on New Year's Eve, Dec. 31, after the 10:00 a.m. Mass when the *Te Deum* is recited or chanted in thanksgiving for favors received in the past year.

They can also gain a Plenary Indulgence on New Year's Day, Jan. 1, before the 10:00 a.m. Mass when the *Veni Creator Spiritus* is recited or chanted for the whole of the coming year.

The usual spiritual conditions apply.

After the Epiphany water and chalk are blessed, they will be available at the side entrance to take and bless your homes.
