Good Shepherd Sunday

The Second Sunday of Easter is known as "Good Shepherd Sunday" because the Mass reading is taken from the Gospel of John, where Jesus uses the imagery of a shepherd guiding and guarding his flock to describe His relationship with those He has redeemed: "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (Jn. 10:11). The communion antiphon for this Mass reads, "The Good Shepherd is risen! He who laid down his life for his sheep, who died for his flock, he is risen, alleluia." Good Shepherd Sunday is also recognized as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, where the faithful pray that God will send them

good and holy priests who, following the example of Christ, will lay down their lives

for His sheep.



The month of April is traditionally dedicated to devotion to Jesus in the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The Catholic Church teaches that the Blessed Sacrament is the real and living presence of Christ; His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity received into our souls with every reception of Holy Communion. Our Eucharistic Lord is the source and summit of our Christian life, the ultimate proof of His infinite love for us.
