Dear faithful,

In *The Liturgical Year*, Dom Guéranger has some choice criticisms on Low Sunday of the modernist and rationalistic faith of liberal Catholics:

"...How cold and powerless is this faith! How cramped and ashamed! How afraid of believing too much! Unlike the generous unstinted faith of the saints, it is satisfied with fragments of truth, with what the Scripture terms diminished truths. (Psalm 11:2) It seems ashamed of itself. It speaks in a whisper, lest it should be criticized; and when it does venture to make itself heard, it adopts a phraseology, which may take off the sound of the divine. As to those miracles which it wishes had never taken place, and which it would have advised God not to work, they are a forbidden subject...it asserts that the same liberty ought to be granted to error as to truth: it has very serious doubts whether the world has been a great loser by the secularization of society."

St. Thomas the Apostle, who unfortunately entertained a doubt regarding Our Lord's Resurrection, nevertheless had the humility to repent, believe with all his heart, and ultimately die a martyr for Christ. May our Paschaltide joy be inspired by his example!
