Dear Faithful:

Ave Maria. After almost a year of uncertainty in the journey to obtain a proper Church, one thing remains constant: God reigns. 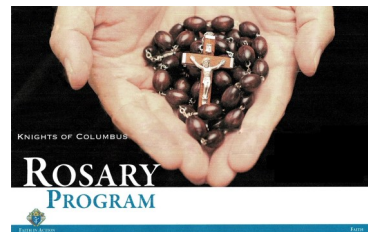
