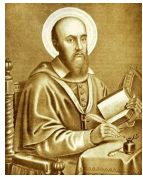

### The Second Sunday After Epiphany



At that time, there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee: and the mother of Jesus was there. And Jesus also was invited, and his disciples, to the marriage. And the wine failing, the mother of Jesus saith to Him: They have no wine. And Jesus saith to her: Woman, what is that to Me and to thee? My hour is not yet come. His mother saith to the waiters: Whatsoever He shall say to you, do ye. Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three measures apiece. Jesus saith to them: Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim. And Jesus said to them: Draw out now, and carry to the chief steward of the feast. And they carried it. And when the chief steward had tasted the water made wine, and knew not whence it was, but the waiters knew who had drawn the water: the chief steward calleth the bridegroom, and saith to him: Every man at first setteth forth good wine, and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now. This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee: and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

### When does the Christmas Season End?

The Christmas Season ends with Candlemas. The Church has traditionally celebrated the Christmas season for forty days, from Christmas Day to February 2, which is the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also called Candlemas. There is a Fourth-Century A.D. eyewitness account of the Feast of the Forty Days by a pilgrim named Egeria. In the beginning of the Christian era, Christ's birth was celebrated, along with the Epiphany, on January 6, so Egeria wrote of a procession and Mass in Jerusalem on the fortieth day after Epiphany. When Christmas was later moved to December 25, the date of the Feast of the Forty Days was moved back also, to February 2. Sometime before the Eighth Century, February 2 also began to be celebrated as the Marian Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

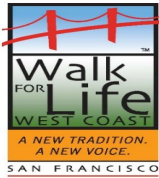

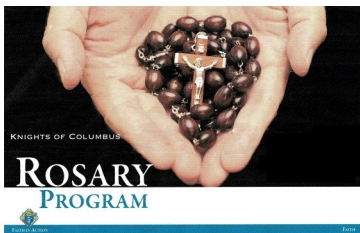
