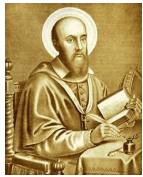

St. Francis de Sales, Principal Patron Saint of the Institute of Christ the King

Today we are celebrating the External Solemnity of St. Francis de Sales, who, aside from serving as a Bishop, was also a mystic, a Doctor of the Church and founder of a religious order. Through his life we can see the qualities a bishop should have as well as what a holy bishop can accomplish through his sacred ministry. A man of action, St. Francis de Sales was the bishop of Geneva, Switzerland, which, at that time, had become a bastion of Protestantism after Calvin had conquered the whole region. But the saintly bishop was goaded on through many hardships by a vivid awareness of his responsibilities as a shepherd to those souls whom God had entrusted to his care. Through his zeal, his loving kindness and his understanding, he was able to persevere through many adversities to bring many back to the Catholic Faith. May St. Francis de Sales continue to intercede for

us as we continue to labor in the midst of a culture of death.

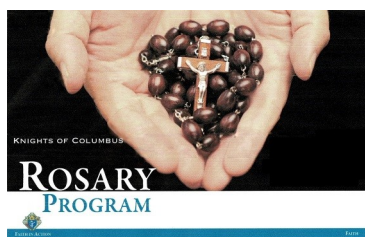
