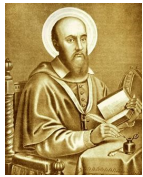

At that time, Jesus spoke to His disciples this parable: There was a certain rich man who had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods; and he called him, and said to him: How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship, for now thou canst be steward no longer. when I shall be removed from the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses. Therefore calling together every one of his lord's debtors, he said to the first: How much dost thou owe my lord? But he said: A hundred barrels of oil. And he said to him: Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty. Then he said to another: And how much dost thou owe? Who said: A hundred quarters of wheat. He said to him: Take thy bill, and write eighty. And the lord commended the unjust steward, for as much as he had done wisely: for the children of this world are wiser in their generation than the children of light. And I say to you: Make unto you friends of the mammon of iniquity, that when you shall fail, they may received you into everlasting dwellings.

Eucharistic Adoration Every Saturday

Dear Faithful,

In an effort to obtain a closer relationship with God and combat the increasing evil in our world that threatens ourselves, our families, our country and our church, Eucharistic Adoration will be held every Saturday for one hour after the 9 a.m. Mass. A sign up sheet will be provided with a request that each parishioner commit to at least one or more hours a month. Jesus said to St. Margaret Mary "I have a burning thirst to be honored by men in the Blessed Sacrament, and I find hardly anyone who strives, according to My desire, to allay this thirst by making Me some return of love." We answer with a commitment to keep Our Lord company for just a short time with assurance that the devil will flee and prayers will be answered. During Adoration we will be reciting the rosary and ask that all parishioners recite 1-3 rosaries daily as part of a Rosary campaign. The Rosary, especially prayed in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, is a powerful means of spiritual grace. Blessed Carlo Acutis said "After the holy Eucharist, the holy Rosary is the most powerful weapon for fighting the devil and the shortest ladder for climbing into heaven." These two devotions are what is needed for our prayers to be answered as well as spiritual enrichment and grace to guide us in these troubled times. I ask each of you commit to these devotions.

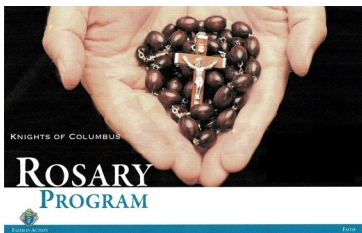
