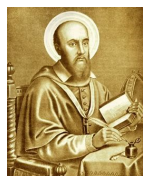

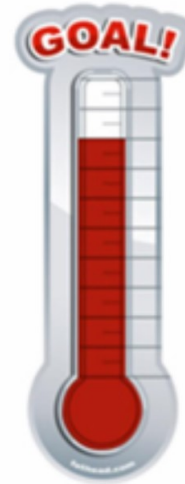


Christmas Flower Donation Envelopes

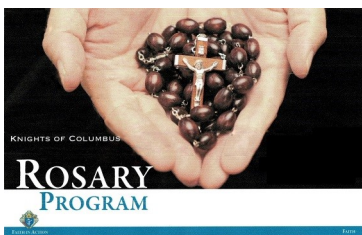
