Special Blessing of Epiphany Holy Water

On Monday, January 6, after Low Mass at noon, there will be a special blessing of Epiphany Holy Water. This special Holy Water recalls the waters of the Jordan River and is a visible reminder of Christ's Divinity revealed by His Heavenly Father at His Baptism. This blessed Epiphany water also recalls the water changed miraculously by Christ into wine at Cana as a foreshadowing of the institution of the Holy Eucharist.

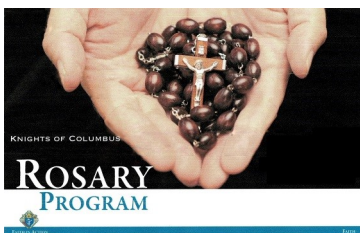
