Liturgical Note

Septuagesimatide, or pre-Lent, is the name given to the two and a half weeks, with its three consecutive Sundays, preceding Ash Wednesday. It is named after the first of these, Septuagesima Sunday, which occurs roughly seventy days before Easter (Septuagesima is Latin for seventieth). Sexagesima (sixtieth) comes next, followed by Quinquagesima (fiftieth) which is the Sunday before Ash Wednesday, March 5.

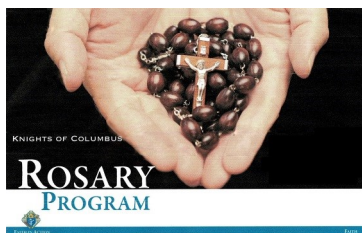
