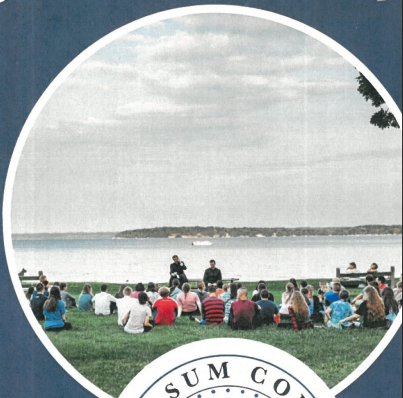

HOLY MATRIMONY:

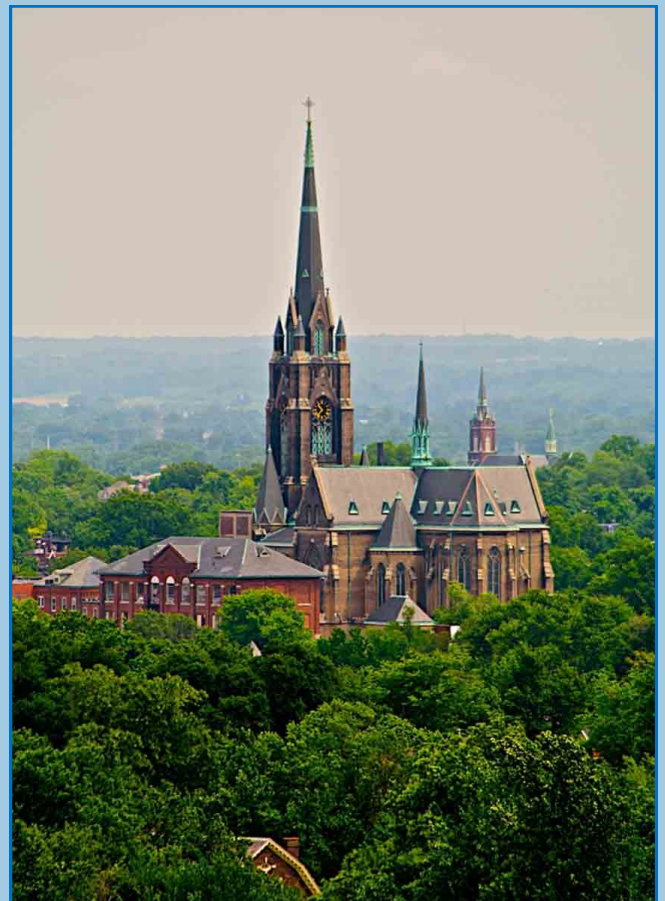
Couples planning to marry at the Oratory must call the rectory for the proper instructions.
