





The decision to overturn Roe vs Wade, more than a year ago, was certainly a great victory; but the spiritual war against abortion is still going on. We could even say that this spiritual war has increased. Dear faithful, when was the last time you have come to pray publicly at the gate of Planned Parenthood, to spiritually and physically support the sidewalk counselors in their difficult task? Too often, we procrastinate: "this week is too busy... Next time..." And we procrastinate again and again. In order to help each other to come more regularly, I propose to fix the first Thursday of every month as the "St Francis de Sales Oratory's Watch Duty" Let's go pray the holy rosary in family, groups of friends or alone, anytime between 9:00 am until 7:00 pm at PP Fairview Heights. Why Thursday? Because Thursday is their, most sadly, busiest day! Why a day for the Oratory: for two reasons: First, it will help some to come more regularly; but mainly because abortion is not just a personal issue: it is mainly a society issue. So every level of the society have to raise and fight against it: from the first level of society, which are families; until the highest level of society, which is the Catholic Church, but passing through all the intermediary level of society: companies, neighborhoods, parishes, cities, counties, dioceses and states...Let's go and pray, whatever the weather: they do not stop killing babies when it is too hot or rainy...
